ROAD MAP TO SERVICES

ADULT CLINICAL SERVICES:

Central's *Outpatient Program*, offers behavioral and co-occurring treatment (individual, family and group therapy utilizing empirically supported treatments), crisis and emergency intervention, comprehensive intake assessments, and medication management.

Central's *Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)* is a comprehensive therapeutic experience, including behavioral and cognitive skills training, symptom and medication understanding and management techniques, family psycho-education and peer mentoring.

Central's **<u>Partial Hospital Program for the Elderly (Oasis)</u>** supports seniors with dementia, depression and anxiety in a group setting to meet the special needs of the older adults.

Central's *Clinical Options Toward Recovery (CORE)* program is firmly committed to helping those who suffer from addiction, co-dependency, and co-occurring disorders to achieve stability and abstinence, and to eventually rebuild healthy and fulfilling lives.

ADULT SERVICES:

Central's <u>Recovery Coaching</u> and <u>Case Management Services</u>, partner with consumers to coordinate, facilitate or provide resources to help secure housing, crisis intervention, mental health services, socialization, rehabilitation services, and much more. <u>Senior</u> <u>Case Management</u> services are available for individuals 60 years of age and older. Central's <u>Administrative Case Manager (ACM)</u> provides information and referrals for behavioral health and other human services, including other county departments and coordination agencies.

Central's *Clinical Wellness Recovery Team (CWRT)* provides services to help improve the physical and behavioral health care that a member receives to ensure an integrated healthcare approach to wellness.

Central's <u>Career Center</u> provides career focused workshops and related services such as support for securing a job, assistance with examining long term career options, and support for education towards career goals. Our <u>Certified Peer Specialists (CPS)</u> offers individuals support towards their goal oriented recovery plan. <u>Generalist CPS</u> support individuals to become part of the community in which they live. We also offer an <u>Older</u> <u>Adult CPS</u> service that assists individuals 60 and older to increase their socialization and to improve their quality of life.
